



## Cpl. Tomer Amar



**August 12, 2006 – Cpl. Tomer Amar, 19, of Julis, was one of 19 soldiers killed in fighting against Hizbullah terrorists in southern Lebanon.**

Tomer Amar was on sick leave from the army, when he heard that friends from his commando unit had been wounded in the fighting. "He immediately went back to the front to rejoin his unit," said his cousin Nashib.

"He was a beautiful person," added Nashib. "He was very active, strong and courageous. He was known in our village as someone who loved riding horses."

Tomer's father, who is retired from the Ministry of Agriculture, had already built a home for Tomer next to his own, but Tomer will never live in it. One of Tomer's brothers is a Major in a combat engineering unit, and another brother is a Masters student at Haifa University.

Cpl. Tomer Amar was buried in Julis. He is survived by his parents and three siblings.
