



Warrant Officer Lutfi Nasraladin



Dec 29, 2008 - Warrant Officer Lutfi Nasraladin, 38, of the Druze town of Daliat el-Carmel, was killed by a mortar attack on a military base near Nahal Oz.

On Monday evening, mortar fire from Gaza struck an IDF base in the western Negev, near Nahal Oz. Warrant Officer Lutfi Nasraladin, a career officer in the Border Police, was killed. Several other soldiers were wounded, one severely.

Nasraladin was named after an uncle who was killed in action in the Jordan Valley a year before he was born. His grandfather, Amal Nasraladin, served as a Member of Knesset for the Likud party from 1977 to 1988.

Warrant Officer Lutfi Nasraladin will be buried in the military cemetery of Ussafia.
